BOOKS BY HAND

FROM HISTORICAL MANUSCRIPTS TO CONTEMPORARY GESTURAL WRITING

with Monica Dengo

Arezzo, September 10 - 16, 2011



Books by Hand is a calligraphy and bookbinding workshop held every year in Arezzo, a medieval art city in Tuscany, near Florence. Students study and work at the Palazzo Pretorio, site of the Public Library, and in another spacious and comfortable room at walking distance from the city center. They accommodate in a holiday home facing the gorgeous Piazza Grande, or in a youth hostel also well located in the city center where it's easy to find small trattoria's and typical restaurants, sit at cafés by the piazzas and enjoy the many beauties of this medieval town.

In this unique course students study the historical hands directly from the sources: manuscripts, documents, correspondence. They also develop their own hands, experimenting with forms, inks, instruments, papers. Each student completes at least a couple of books, but often they are able to go home with several.

This year we will study XVI to XVIII century correspondence and documents written in a multiplicity of italic hands. We will also have the opportunity to study directly on manuscripts from various periods, paying special attention to spacing and page design. Students will then develop their own personal Italic hands, taking special care about letters and line spacing, page design, rhythm. We will study and experiment with the different possibilities of writing fluently and legibly or more expressively and experimentally.

At the end of this workshop students will learn how to make a folded book for their notes and studies and a sewn book for all the experimental works. They will learn how to use the right papers and make the sewing, and how to measure, mark, fold, cut and make the covers with handmade paper.

Students from many parts of the world have participated in this workshop which has become a well known yearly event among lettering artists, calligraphers and bookbinding lovers.

TUTOR:

Monica Dengo is an artist and a professional calligrapher. She has taught for several years at the Academy of Art University in San Francisco - California and gives workshops worldwide.

LOCATION:

Arezzo - Italy

Lessons will be held in a large and luminous room near the train station and at the Arezzo Public Library located in the Arezzo historical center www.bibliotecarezzo.it. The library offers free internet access and also a wi-fi service which extends to the nearby parks. If you wish, you can bring your own lap-top.

DATES:

Arrival: September 9th. Evening drink . Class begins on Saturday September 10th.

Class ends on Friday September 16th. Departures from Saturday September 17th.

TUITION:

7 days with Monica Dengo. 9:00 am to 4:00 pm (small lunch break). Wednesday is free.

ACCOMODATION:

Students will accommodate in a holiday home and a youth hostel, both situated at walking distance from the classrooms. Arezzo historical center is small and full of narrow streets and typical restaurants with reasonable prices.
